YOU MUST REGISTER TO VOTE! YOU MUST VOTE!!!

Voting is the birthright that was fought for us by our ancestors on whose shoulders we stand. We are living in challenging times, with National Leadership taking away your rights to live, work, receive an education, vote, and have economic opportunities.

Leadership across the country has voted to restrict who is eligible to vote and to redesign boundaries that will impact legislative representation.

The U.S. Supreme Court has significantly weakened the Voting Rights Act through a series of landmark decisions that have dismantled key enforcement mechanisms and restricted the law's protections against racial discrimination in voting and redistricting.

Your responsibility as a good citizen is to participate and vote to ensure your interests and voice are heard by those in government. This is important for you, your family, and future generations.

Educate yourself and keep abreast of important issues in your neighborhood, city, county, region, state, and nationally. Vote in all elections, local, county, regional, state, and national elections. Attend and participate in town hall discussions, meetings, and community summits on issues.

Make sure you are registered to vote with the Multnomah County Elections Office at (503) 988-3720, 1040 SE Morrison Street, 97214, website: elections@multco.us. You can register online or in person.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: 21ST DAY AT 11:59 PM PST BEFORE AN ELECTION TO BE ELIGIBLE.

ELECTION DAY: MAIL-IN BALLOTS SIGNED AND POSTMARKED BY 8:00 PM ELECTION DAY AT THE OFFICIAL BALLOT DROP-OFF SITE OR MULTNOMAH COUNTY ELECTIONS OFFICE.

ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE IN OREGON:

- **MUST BE A US CITIZEN**
- **MUST BE A RESIDENT OF OREGON**
- **YOU ARE AT LEAST 16 YEARS OLD. YOU WILL GET YOUR FIRST BALLOT IN THE MAIL WHEN YOU ARE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD.**
- **YOU CAN SIGN UP TO VOTE IF YOU HAVE A FELONY ON YOUR RECORD AND HAVE FINISHED YOUR SENTENCE.**
- **YOU CAN SIGN UP TO VOTE IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS OR HOUSING INSECURITY. CALL MULTNOMAH COUNTY ELECTIONS ABOUT VOTING ELIGIBILITY.**
- **YOU MUST PRESENT AN OREGON DRIVER'S LICENSE, PERMIT, OR ID CARD NUMBER ISSUED BY THE OREGON DRIVER AND MOTOR VEHICLES SERVICES DIVISION (DMV)**
- **IF YOU DON'T HAVE AN OREGON DRIVER'S LICENSE, PERMIT, OR ID CARD, THE LAST 4 DIGITS OF YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, AND SIGNATURE, YOU CAN STILL USE THE ONLINE SYSTEM, BUT YOU WILL NEED ACCESS TO A PRINTER. AFTER ENTERING YOUR INFORMATION, A PDF OF YOUR VOTER REGISTRATION CARD WILL APPEAR, PRINT IT, SIGN IT, AND MAIL OR DELIVER TO MULTNOMAH COUNTY ELECTIONS OFFICE.**
- **YOU MAY REQUEST ASSISTANCE WITH LANGUAGE PREFERENCE.**
- **YOU MAY REQUEST ASSISTANCE IF YOU HAVE A DISABILITY.**
